

Freedom of Information Request – SEEDA Property

Thank you for your request dated 20th July 2011 and made under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your request to SEEDA is:

Please provide details of agency property, including furniture, vehicles, equipment, sold at auction in each year since establishment, showing the following information:

- *Name of the property*
- *cost at purchase*
- *price at sale.*

You have confirmed that your request relates to 'moveable property' only and therefore excludes SEEDA's land and property assets. I can confirm that SEEDA have not disposed of any property by way of auction since the Agency was established in 1999.

As you will be aware all Regional Development Agencies, including SEEDA, are to close by the 31st March 2012. SEEDA's Executive Closure Board and Audit Committee have decided that all surplus business related assets (including ICT equipment and furniture) will be disposed of by the Disposal Standards Authority (DSA), which is a Government organisation. Please see <http://www2.edisposals.com/index.htm> for further details. The DSA will ensure that all ICT equipment has been 'cleaned' to the required security standard. All items will then be disposed of by the DSA via sale at open market. The funds received by the DSA will be returned to SEEDA or to the public purse if we have already closed by that time.
